### 2010 On-Campus Interviews and Information Sessions

- **Spring 2010 Recruiting:** Early-Bird reservations are available on February 10 & 11, followed by the Pre-select Process for the rest of the season.
- **Fall 2010 Recruiting:** Reservations of Room Only and Open Sign-up Interviews through DiggerNet from Career Day to September 24. This is followed by the Pre-select Process which makes resume review, candidate selection and appointment scheduling easy for employers and students.
- **Information Sessions:** Many companies use these meetings to kick off their on-campus interviewing event. Information sessions provide a convenient way of presenting information to students who have been selected for interviews. It also provides a way to informally recruit other interested students and fill any vacant slots on the interview schedule.
